

Key objectives

Gain accreditation from Sainsbury's Gold Kitemark and AfPE
Increase number of opportunities for extra-curricular clubs / teams (age groups and both girls and boys)
Improve links with external clubs to create "Champion Pathways"

Time/cost

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Sept	Apply for Gold Kitemark and assure all areas are reached to gain accreditation.	
Oct	Plan for new clubs to join existing clubs for Autumn and Spring term.	
Nov	Find % of children involved in clubs from Summer term and compare to this first autumn term. Target children that do not participate at lunch or in clubs.	
Dec	Contact external clubs to begin to forge links	
Jan	Identify children to push through pathways / gifted areas. (Autumn sports)	Meetings with parents if necessary.
Feb	Apply for Afpe registration and accreditation.	Reg money from PE budget
Mar	Organise a girls football day and club in order to identify talented children and to raise participation.	Set aside an afternoon to have festival?
Apr	Plan for new clubs to join existing clubs for Summer term.	
May	Assess external club links made and create more for a variety of sports.	email & meetings with club reps.
June	Identify children to push through pathways / gifted areas. (Summer Sports)	meetings with parents if necessary.
July	Final data collected for % of children participating in extra curricular clubs.	

Success criteria

At least one of the accreditations to be awarded to the school.
Participation data to be recorded and a variety of clubs to be offered across the two key stages.
At least two clubs links to be forged and identified children /families to be made aware of these clubs.
