



Key Stage 1 Results

All children across the country are tested in reading and maths. Schools were also given the option to administer a test for grammar, punctuation and spelling (EGPS). These were all marked internally in order to establish the children's levels of attainment. Writing is assessed by teacher assessment. In 2016 the government changed the method of assessment from national curriculum levels to reporting the proportion of pupils reaching the "expected standard" or "high standard".

Currently no national averages have been released for Key Stage 1.
