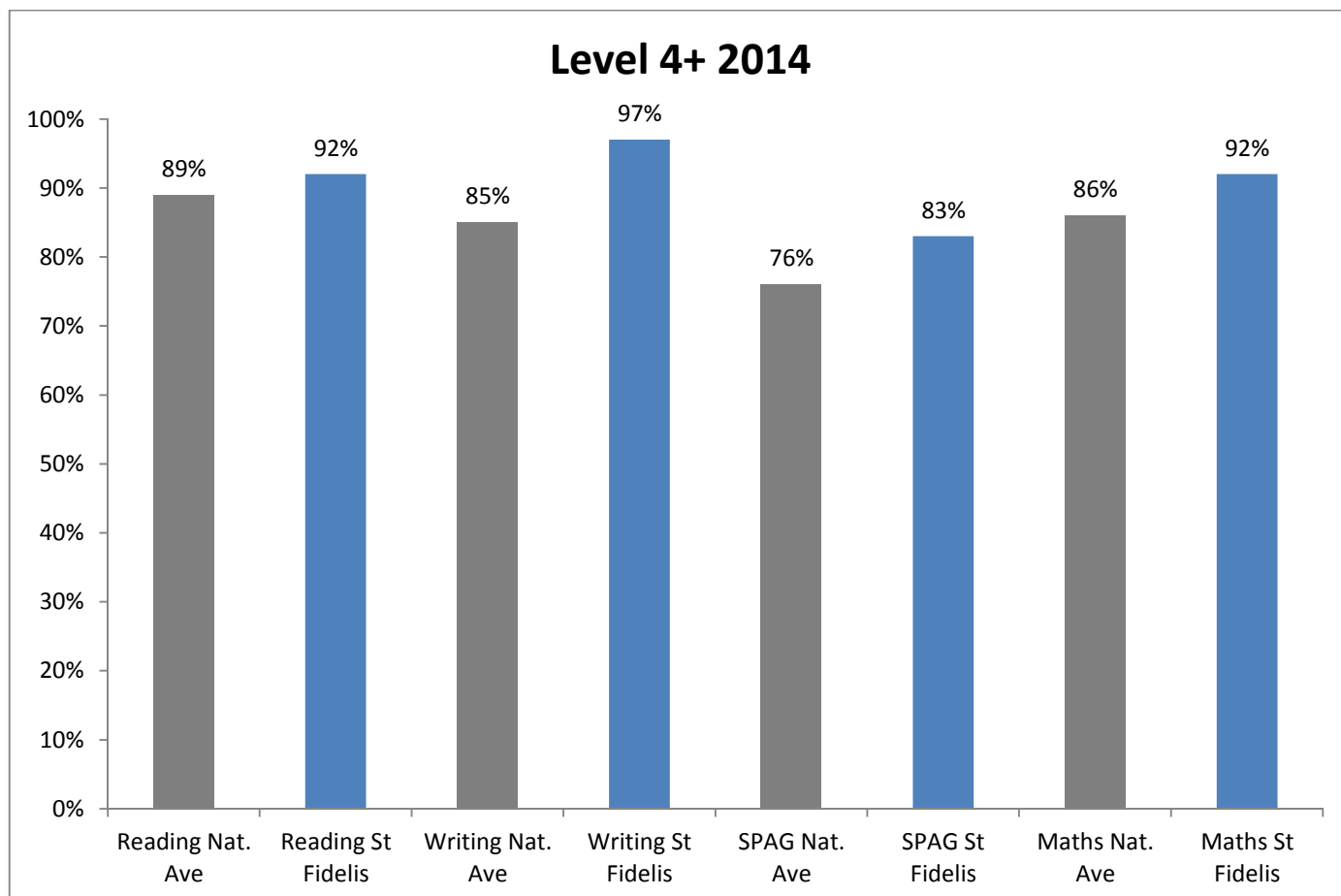




Key Stage 2 Results

All children across the country are tested in reading, spelling, grammar and punctuation (SPAG) and maths through externally marked tests at the end of Year 6 in order to establish their levels of attainment. Writing is assessed by teacher assessment. The expected level of attainment by the end of primary school is Level 4, with more able children attaining Level 5.



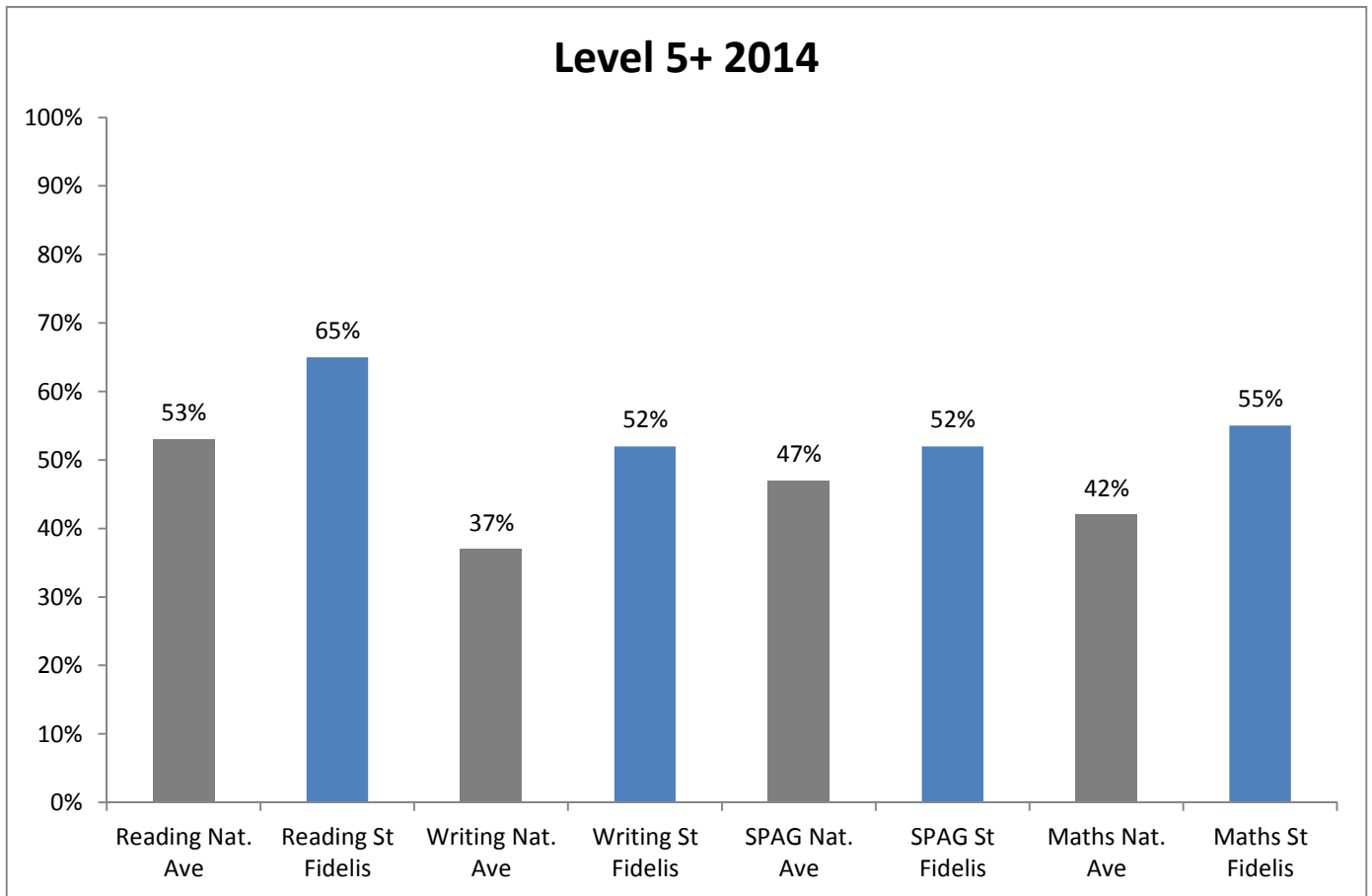
St Fidelis' reading attainment is above the national average and particularly so for the more able (65% of pupils compared to a national average of 53%). Pupils make outstanding progress in reading within the school.

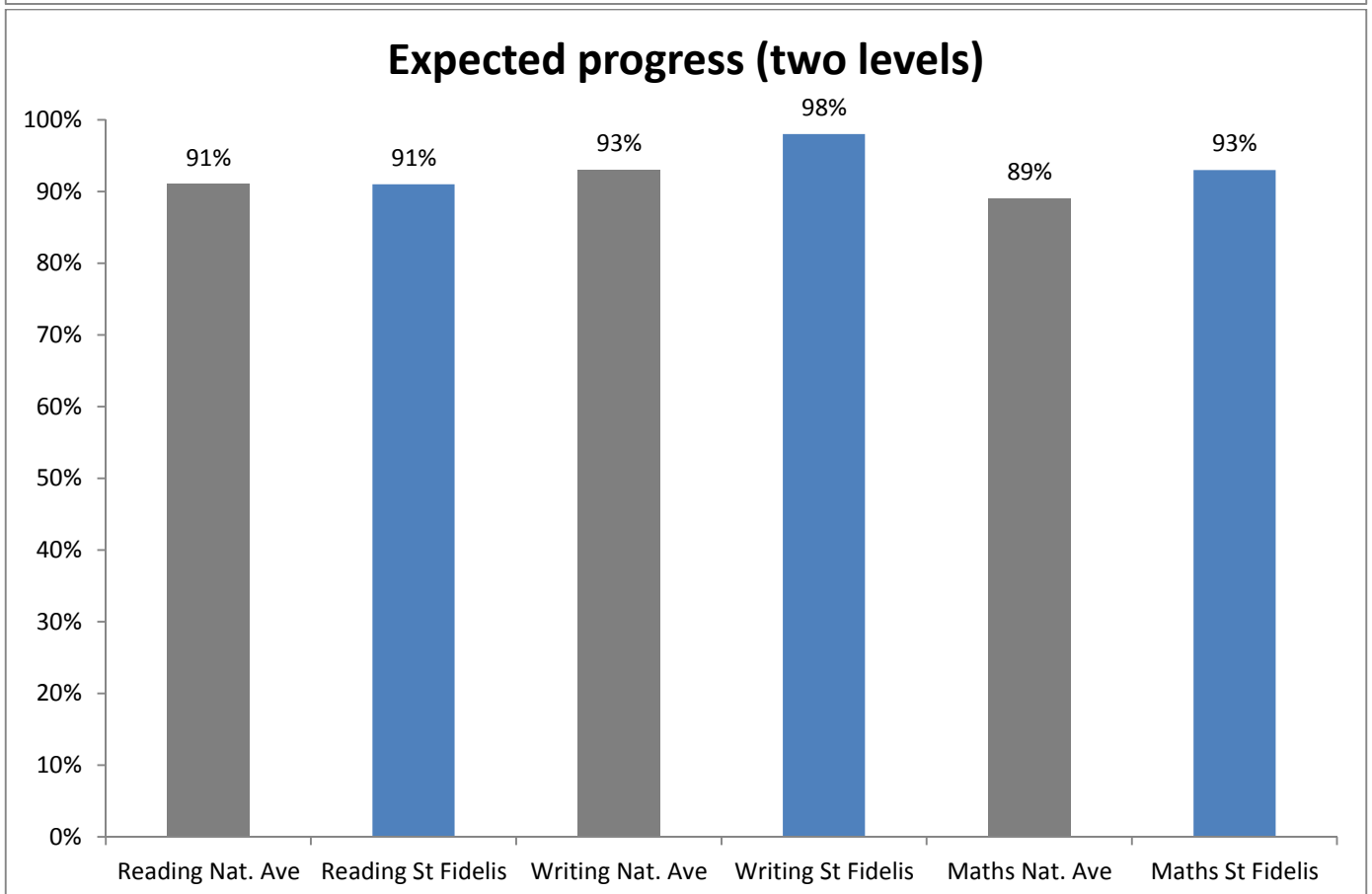
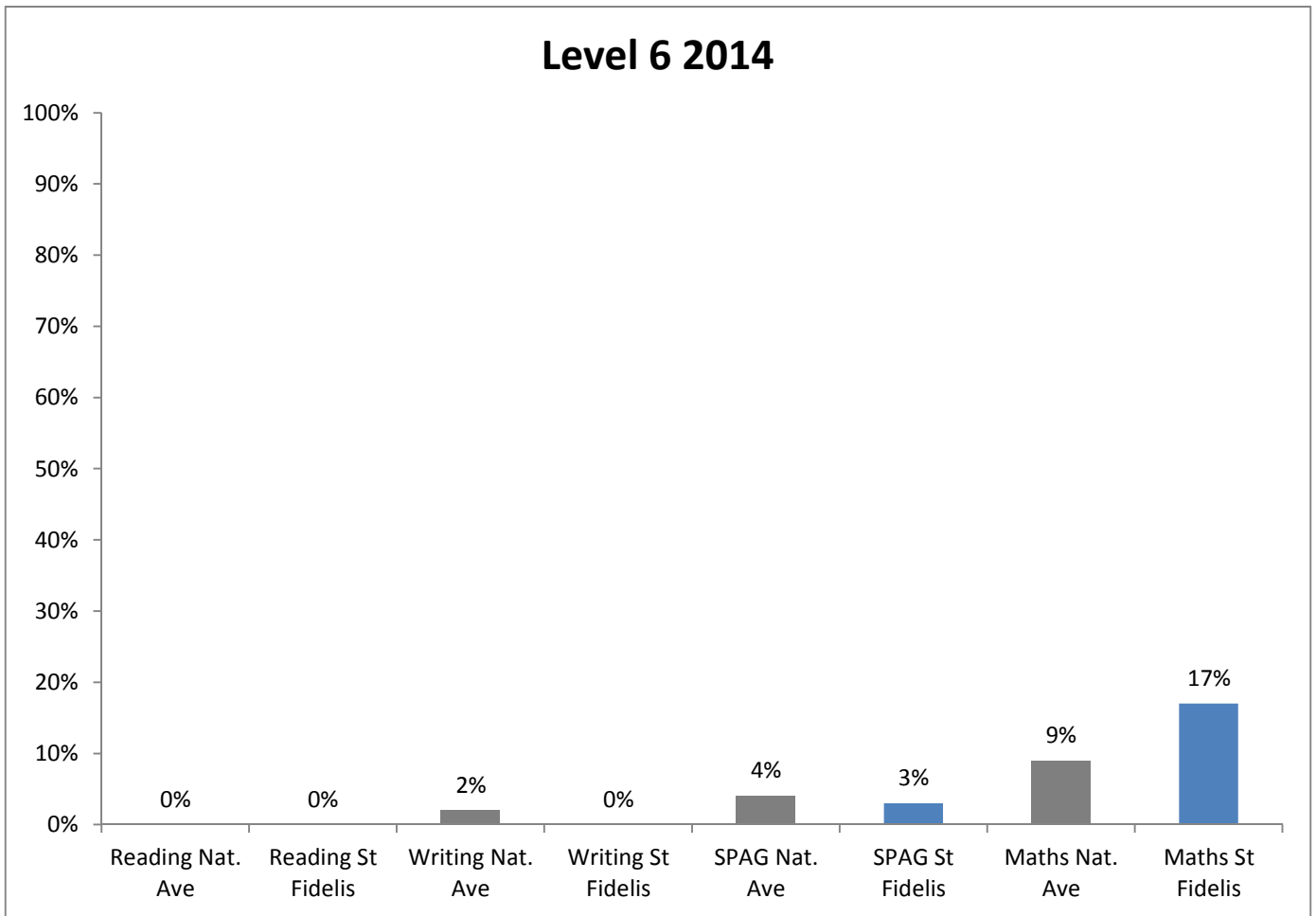
Writing attainment is well above the national average at both level 4 and level 5. Pupils make outstanding progress in writing within the school.

The school results for the SPAG (Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation) tests are above the national average at both level 4 and level 5.

Maths attainment is well above the national average. The school has had considerable success in stretching both the more able pupils to achieve level 5 in this subject (55% of pupils compared to a national average of 42%) and the exceptionally gifted pupils to achieve level 6 in this subject (17% of pupils compared to a national average of 9%).
